Early applications and last year's participants will take priority.

Rules:

*All applications must be mailed or dropped off at the YMCA office by... October 21, 2011.

*Applications need to be submitted every year.

*If more than one crafter is displaying in one booth, pictures from each crafter are required. Please provide details on application.

*Crafters will be selected by a committee of three (3) members. Priority will go to crafters who plan to display on both days.

*No refunds for short notice of cancellation or "no-shows." Short notice = two weeks prior to show.

*A waiting list of crafters will be called to replace cancellations.

*Space rental (8' X 8') is \$35 for 1st year crafters; \$30 for returnees.

*Tables are not part of fee, but can be ordered in advance at an additional \$10.00/table.

*"No-Shows" will be banned from participations for the next five years.

DESCRIPTION OF CRAFT OR BUSINESS:

Attn: Food Vendors

The Nebraska Department of Agriculture does not permit the selling of the following items at Craft Shows:

- All low acid canned foods in hermetically sealed containers, including pickles and salsa;
- Unpasteurized milk, yogurt;
- Cheese or any food item containing cheese
- Foods from unapproved sources.

A clearly visible placard is required at the point of sale stating the food was not prepared in an inspected, licensed food preparation area. A placard is not required if the food was prepared in an inspected, licensed facility. We will be providing signs for any one selling food that was not made in a licensed facility.
